June 12, 2017

The regularly scheduled meeting of the Red Hill Water Authority took place at 7:00 PM on Monday June 12, 2017. The following officers were present:

Mr. Palencar led a review of the May minutes. After the review Mr. Stever made a motion, seconded by Sandy Bergey to approve the minutes as read. Motion carried

Mr. Palencar led a review of the 2016 financial statement. After the review Mr. Stever made a motion, seconded by Chris McMahon to approve the financial statement. Motion carried.

Mr. Palencar led a discussion on an issue with The Upper Hanover Authority giving permission to various entities to draw water from Red Hill Water Authority sources. It appears the issue has been resolved.

A discussion was held on a PennDOT request to move the hydrant at Route 29 & Seisholtzville Road. It was noted that PennDOT had previously approved the location.

It was noted that double wall containment tanks had been purchased for sodium hypochlorite tanks for the chlorination systems at the well houses.

Mr. Palencar noted that he planned to attend an open house for solar panels on June 16.

A discussion was held on the number of meters replaced. There were 21 meters replaced this billing period.

Mr. Palencar led a discussion on a customer the Authority had been unable to contact in regards to a meter upgrade. Mr. Stever made a motion, seconded by Chris McMahon to send a certified letter to the customer if the Authority was unable to contact after this week.

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Mr. Stever led a discussion in regards to the fading of the colors on the recently repainted hydrants.

It was noted that the Authority had received the new meter reader.

A discussion was held on a new meter for the Hope Valley Community Church.

Mr. Stever made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Chris McMahon. Motion carried.
